Good morning, everyone,

Permits for Pool are finalized.

Zoning has completed their review and found there was no discrepancies with our original plans. Once they signed off the pool permits have been finalized. Activity will resume at the pool; you will now be seeing trucks arrive with materials and work to begin the process. This week of course will be a slow start, but we will be seeing activity for sure.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we were dealing with this delay. Once the permits are given to us with the Palm Beach County seal, we will print them and have them on a table in the lobby of the B Building for those that want to see them. Please, if you have any questions, do not hesitate to contact us, do not go out to the pool area to ask questions, nor call the county, send us an email and we will get you the answers.

NO homeowner is allowed past the gate into the fenced in pool area for insurance, liability, and safety issues.

Huge shout out to the Plats for having Plat 4/5 welcomed to their pools. Plat 3 has opened their pool to all of 4/5. Plats 1 and 2 are available to 4/5 homeowners if you go through a friend. All Plats have been so welcoming during this heat wave, and we the Board of Directors are thankful for the community spirit, and the new friendships that have developed. Thanks.

Permits for Tennis Courts in for Review:

The tennis courts permits are in for review and final approval; it will take approx. 3 weeks to get through it. You will see the safety fences go up by the tennis area and the start of the demolition. Again, any questions, contact the Rec Board, not the county nor the vendors. Once we get through the County review and they finalize the prints we will also put those sealed plans in the B Building.

We will update and send additional photos as we progress. Again, thanks for the support and the patience you have shown us through this process. We, the Rec Board of Directors, appreciate it.

Finance Committee:

Financials for the Special Assessment are located on the homeowner page under Special Assessment Financials, any questions, please send an email to camille@delrayvillasrec.com and we will send to the Finance Committee for the answer. We were fortunate to have the Finance Committee take on this task and ensuring the correct information is posted, and all funds are accounted for. David Del Gasio is compiling it for the Finance Committee; they are all reviewing it before it is posted. Please note: the finance committee names are Tom Dempsey, Chairman Plat 2, David Del Gasio Plat 1, Richard Chrzan Plat 3, Renee Ward Plat 4/5, (Bill Yesowitch was appointed by me to assist me and the board since he has followed this community financials for years). This group of homeowners are an articulate, awesome group, extremely knowledgeable in all financials, an asset to the Rec Board and the community. They report to the Board of Directors. They are homeowners just like everyone else. Not elected to the position but were kind enough to come forward and contribute and work for the community. They would like their privacy respected and do not wish to have their emails and phone numbers listed in the Rec News or on the website. They would prefer an email sent to me and I forward it to them so they can discuss the questions all together as a team not individually to homeowners. We have stated that when they were first formed, we get persistent requests for their information, which we will not be posting or sharing. Thank you for your understanding and respect for their

privacy. Kudos to all 5 of you for all you do and yes, I misinformed you, it was only 1 meeting a month, but it is constant correspondence and interaction, but we became a team and I could not be prouder of all of you. Thanks.

NOTE: REPAIRS COMPLETED NOT ON SPECIAL ASSESSMENT FUNDING ON OUR REGULAR REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT OPERATING COST:

The new LED lights have been put in the gym, and we are now compliant with the exit signs and emergency lighting in the gym. Also, we had to make an emergency installation of LED lights in the B Building bathrooms, and the gym bathrooms. There are pictures that were taken to show this was a life safety issue. They had no junction boxes and just wires with wire nuts exposed in the ceilings. There are photos available if you wish to see them. The Board of Directors reviewed photos, discussed, and we moved forward with the repair.

Gym equipment has been ordered: 3 Integrity+ treadmills and 1 Recumbent Bike. They will take approximately 10-12 weeks for delivery. Kudos to Andrea Presser and Mark Cafiero for a phenomenal job in getting the best machines at great pricing. It came in at \$34,000 dollars once delivery was added. Huge shouted out to Mark for getting them to go under budget at \$29,993.18.

Andrea and Mark thank you for an exceptional job and to both of you for the growth of homeowners in the gym, your expertise, and abilities to bring the community together shine through every day. Thank you. All homeowners: we now have a signup sheet and have hired Ryan, a licensed, insured, and trained fitness instructor to show you how to use the machines. We are all impressed that so many have taken advantage of this opportunity. The sign up the sheet is in the gym, under Alexa, or you can email us and we will get your name on the list.

Once again, the support of this community is so appreciated and overwhelming, as the Rec Board moves forward with many turning wheels at one time. Thank you for your understanding, support, and respectful discussions, and for understanding that this Board works diligently as volunteers. To the Rec Board of Director, I must say how thankful I am for every board member and for the love and dedication that you have for this community and the time and effort that you put forth. I truly appreciate each of you and we are a spectacular team that works together through hard work, tough discussions, peaceful solutions, and each and every one of us always has the know with all that it is not what is best for us as individuals it is what is best for the Delray Villas Community as a whole.
